## CONDITIONS OF ENROLLMENT

### TRANSPORTATION

- ⇒ Transportation is a personal responsibility. Please contact your Corps Officer to see if they are making travel arrangements as a group.
- ⇒ By signing this application, I give permission for transportation to, and participation in, any off site program activities.

### PAYMENT

- ⇒ All fees and applications must be submitted to your Corps Officer.

### CHAPERONES

- ⇒ Every Corps is responsible to provide an adequate number of chaperones for all male/female delegates.

### MEDICAL

- ⇒ Any additional medical expense (medications, treatment, and transportation) will become the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian.
- ⇒ In case of medical emergency, every effort will be made to contact the parent or legal guardian.
- ⇒ Delegates bringing any medication to the retreat must have medication in original containers. An adequate supply of prescribed medication must be sent for the duration of the weekend.

### GUIDELINES

- ⇒ The Salvation Army is not responsible for loss or damage of personal items.
- ⇒ Out of respect for others, music must be kept to an acceptable level.
