TRANSPORTATION

PAYMENT

⇒ All fees and applications must be submitted to your Corps Officer.

CHAPERONES

- ⇒ Every Corps is responsible to provide an **ADEQUATE NUMBER** of chaperones for all male/female delegates.
- ⇒ Information related to the delegates for which you are responsible.

MEDICAL

- ⇒ Any additional medical expense (medications, treatment, and transportation) will become the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian.
- ⇒ In case of medical emergency, every effort will be made to contact the parent or legal guardian.
- ⇒ Delegates bringing any medication to the retreat must have medication in original containers. An adequate supply of prescribed medication must be sent for the duration of the weekend.

GUIDELINES

- ⇒ Electronic devices are permitted at camp but not during sessions.
- ⇒ The Salvation Army is not responsible for loss or damage of personal items.
- ⇒ Out of respect for others, music must be kept to an acceptable level.
- ⇒ Casual wear is our dress code. Modesty and comfort is what we love and it honours God too!
- ⇒ Please bring your own bedding, bible and pen, appropriate clothing in case of inclement weather.
- ⇒ The following items and behaviours are not permitted during camp:
Tobacco, Vaping, Roughhousing, Alcohol/Drugs, Gambling, Foul language, Pranks, Inappropriate behavior.
